MP explained that this is due to programme efficiency as this is the most efficient approach to the task. The resident was also keen to understand if any tenants will be in Building 3 prior to full competition. MP explained that Multiplex need to provide a shell to any future tenant before competition, allowing tenants to fit out their own office space prior to occupation.</li> <li>3.11 A resident queried as to why the lights within Building 3 are kept on at night.
