

#### Welcome to our February update

Multiplex Construction Europe is a premier global construction company that has been shaping skylines and delivering iconic projects for over 55 years. We are delighted to have been tasked with delivering the Bankside Yards West development, situated in the London Borough of Southwark.


Bankside Yards West is part of a new mixed-use development scheme comprising of residential and commercial buildings along with retail units and public spaces. The basement is shared with all three buildings.

Building 3 consists of a 20 storey, 300,000sqft GIA, high quality office building which sits at the corner of Southwark Street and Blackfriars Road and is adjacent to, and partly above the Network Rail viaduct. The office building is intended to be BCO compliant and achieve BREEAM Excellent.

- For Building 3, Tower Crane 1a has now been fully dismantled, leaving only one crane (TC2) remaining in situ until Q4 2021
- Erection of the steel frame to Building 3 is progressing well on Levels 18 & 18M, with full concrete floor slabs poured up to Level 14
- Feature brickwork around the core of Building 3 has commenced and will continue through to the end of March 2021.
- Façade bracket installation has commenced to levels 2 and 3 on Building 3 in advance of the façade installation which is due to commence towards the end of March 2021
- Basement (shell) works for Building 2 are in the final stages of completion with handover inspections well under way
- Piling to the Building 1 footprint is now 100% complete and works on the perimeter capping beam have commenced
- A new access point to the Bankside Yards (west) site has been opened on Southwark St.

#### Look Ahead


- The steel frame erection will continue for Building 3, with a target to complete the installation of steel to Level 19 by mid-April 2021
- Bulk excavation to Building 1 basement is due to commence mid-February 2021
- Construction of the first basement slabs in Building 1 are also due to commence in February 2021
- Installation of the Building 3 passenger lifts (x6) are due to commence in March 2021
- Weekly testing of the site fire alarms will continue to take place every Friday at 10:00 and alarms should sound for no longer than 2 minutes



- On Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> Feb 2021, we launched the Construction Learning Programme with Harris Girls' Academy Southwark. This virtual programme will run throughout February, March and April, with the group of Year 10 students tasked with designing and creating a proposal to build a fictional project within London. At the end of the programme the students will be presenting their proposal in front of other competing projects and schools.



#### Welcome to our March update

Multiplex Construction Europe is a premier global construction company that has been shaping skylines and delivering iconic projects for over 55 years. We are delighted to have been tasked with delivering the Bankside Yards West development, situated in the London Borough of Southwark.

Bankside Yards West is part of a new mixed-use development scheme comprising of residential and commercial buildings along with retail units and public spaces. The basement is shared with all three buildings.

Building 3 consists of a 20 storey, 300,000sqft GIA, high quality office building which sits at the corner of Southwark Street and Blackfriars Road and is adjacent to, and partly above the Network Rail viaduct. The office building is intended to be BCO compliant and achieve BREEAM Excellent.

- Erection of the steel frame to Building 3 is progressing well on Levels 18M & 19, with full concrete floor slabs poured up to Level 15
- Feature brickwork around the core of Building 3 has commenced and will continue through to the end of March 2021
- Façade bracket installation has progressed to levels 8 on Building 3 in advance of the façade installation which is due to commence towards the end of March 2021
- Basement (shell) works for Building 2 are in the final stages of completion with blockwork commenced to the back of house rooms in B01
- The lower ground floor slab between Building 2 and 1 has now been poured
- Perimeter supports (whaler beams) have been installed for the Building 1 footprint excavation
- Installation of another lift in Building 3 has commenced (Goods Lift) and completion of the basement Cycle Lifts is expected by mid-March

#### March 2021 Look Ahead


- The steel frame erection for Building 3 is on track to be fully completed by mid-April 2021
- Building 1 substructure works to B01 (50% excavation and 50% top-down construction)
- Commencement of all MEP (Mechanical, Electrical & Plumbing) trades in Building 3 and basement rooms
- Arrival of Building 3 façade panels
- Block walls to B02 of Building 3 to commence
- Concrete pouring of L16 & L17 main slabs in Building 3
- Installation of Building 3 Passenger Lifts will commence first week of March
- Weekly testing of the site fire alarms will continue to take place every Friday at 10:00 and alarms should sound for no longer than 2 minutes
- Weekend works up to 2pm (Building 3 crane & hoist servicing/climbing and general construction activities. Quiet works from 2pm – 4pm (painting of steel beams and columns in Building 3)



- Construction Learning Programme engagement sessions with Harris Girls Academy are progressing well with the latest session hosted on 08th March 2021. The next session will take place on Monday 15th March 2021.
- The first CLG meeting was hosted by Kanda Consulting on Thursday 4th March 2021 with members of the MPX team presenting on project progress. It was fantastic to see some of those who signed up and we look forward to the next meeting



Building 3 consists of a 20 storey, 300,000sqft GIA, high quality office building which sits at the corner of Southwark Street and Blackfriars Road and is adjacent to, and partly above the Network Rail viaduct. The office building is intended to be BCO compliant and achieve BREEAM Excellent.

- Erection of the steel frame to Building 3 is progressing well with final pieces arriving imminently
- All floors up to L18M have been poured
- Feature brickwork around the core of Building 3 has progressed to all elevations
- Façade bracket installation has progressed to L11 on Building 3
- Blockwork throughout Building 3 basement is now complete in B01 and B02
- Building 1 bulk excavation has commenced and McGee have progressed down to formation level (B02) to the north of the site footprint
- Installation of building 3 passenger lifts (x6)
  has commenced
- Mechanical, Electrical & Plumbing (MEP) trades have commenced works in both basement levels underneath Building 3 and are currently working in the cycle store room, male/female change rooms and key utility rooms

#### April - May 2021 Look Ahead

- The steel frame erection for Building 3 is on track to be fully completed by
- The completion of all concrete pours inside Building 3
- Arrival of Building 3 façade panels and commencement of installation
- Out of hours deliveries of oversized façade panels. Panels to arrive between 19:00 & 22:00 once or twice per week to reduce congestion on main roads and offload safely
- Block walls under Building 2 to commence
- Building 1 substructure works (bulk excavation) to continue
- Pouring of the main raft for Building 1
- Restoration works to the southern arches brickwork
- Weekly testing of the site fire alarms will continue to take place every Friday at 10:00 and alarms should sound for no longer than 2 minutes



- Construction Learning Programme engagement sessions with Harris Girls Academy are progressing well. The group are currently on an Easter Break and sessions will resume as of w/c 12<sup>th</sup> April 2021.



- Erection of the steel frame to Building 3 is now complete excluding leave out louvres required for plant installation.
- All floors up to the roof have been poured.
- Feature brickwork around the core of Building 3 has progressed to all elevations.
- Façade panel installation has commenced with skirting panels along the bottom frame.
- Blockwork under Building 2 has commenced install.
- Building 1 bulk excavation has progressed down to formation level (B02) to the north of the site footprint.
- Building 3 passenger lifts (x6) continue to progress with fit out of the lift shafts.
- Mechanical, Electrical & Plumbing (MEP) trades have progressed well in both basement levels underneath Building 3 and have installed a number of life safety plant.

#### May – June 2021 Look Ahead

- Façade panels installation continue up the building.
- The completion of all concrete pours for final upstands on the roof.
- Arrival of transformers and modular risers
- Out of hours deliveries of oversized façade panels. Panels to arrive between 19:00 & 23:00 hrs once or twice per week to reduce congestion on main roads and offload safely.
- Block walls under Building 2 to continue.
- Building 1 substructure works (bulk excavation) to bottom out.
- Restoration works to the southern arches brickwork.
- Weekly testing of the site fire alarms will continue to take place every Friday at 10:00 and alarms should sound for no longer than 2 minutes.





- Roofing installation has progressed across the top two levels of Building 3 inclusive of riser openings
- Masonry is complete on the roof, enclosing the Staircore up to the roof
- Feature brickwork around the core of Building 3 is complete
- Façade panel installation has progress on the East elevation up to level 6 and continues to be installed on the lower floors
- Blockwork under Building 2 continues
- Building 1 bulk excavation is complete and detailed design is awaited fro the raft slab
- · Building 3 lift installation continues to progress
- Mechanical, Electrical & Plumbing (MEP) trades have progressed well in both basement levels and superstructure modular risers
- Riser fit out has commenced on the lower floors in anticipation of riser installation









- Façade panels installation continue up the building
- The completion of waterproofing on the roof levels
- Arrival of transformers and modular risers
- Out of hours deliveries of oversized façade panels. Panels to arrive between 19:00 & 23:00 hrs once or twice per week to reduce congestion on main roads and offload safely
- Block walls under Building 2 to continue

- As part of Multiplex's One Decade to Act carbon reduction pathway, we are working towards the goal of Net Zero onsite emissions by 2025. The project's energy supply is on a renewable electricity tariff, which has eliminated over 120 tonnes of carbon since October 2020





- Façade panel installation has progressed up to level 5 around the entirety of the building while the East elevation is now up to level 12
- Masonry is now complete in the superstructure and progressing well under Building 2
- Building 1 bulk excavation is complete and detailed design is awaited fro the raft slab
- Building 3 lift installation continues to progress
- Mechanical, Electrical & Plumbing (MEP) trades continue to progress with basement works and up to level 3 in the risers with modular risers being delivered to site
- CAT A office fit out has commenced first fix works on levels 4,5,10 and 16
- Riser fit out progressing well up to level 13
