

# Welcome to our January-February 2023 update

Multiplex Construction Europe is a premier global construction company that has been shaping skylines and delivering iconic projects for over 55 years. We are delighted to have been tasked with delivering the Bankside Yards West development, situated in the London Borough of Southwark.

Bankside Yards West is part of a new mixed-use development scheme comprising of residential and commercial buildings along with retail units and public spaces. The basement is shared with all three buildings.

### **Site Progress**

- The Arbor building achieved Practical Completion on the 19<sup>th</sup> December 2022. Ashdown Phillips Partnership are now responsible for operations in the building.
- Contractors are carrying out final checks to the building - 'snagging'
- Hydro demolition activities of localised areas of Building 1, such as concrete slabs and columns are scheduled for completion by the end of February 2023.
- Arches civil works are progressing well.
- · Tenant fit out contractors continue on site.






#### Feb-Mar 2023 Look Ahead

- The project team continue works on arches and basement around the Eastern Yards and Hopton St carpark. The current arches scope of works are due to be completed September 2023.
- External works at Invicta Plaza are scheduled to be completed by the end of February 2023.
- Arches civil works are scheduled for completion in September 2023.
- Multiplex will continue to be responsible for the perimeter of the development for the foreseeable future.
